Can you believe May 2017 is already here? People have told me all my life the older you get the faster time seems to fly and now I am finding that adage to be true. As we enter this wonderful month of May there are a few things I want to make you aware of. First, there are two events in June in which many of you may want to be involved. Second, we will welcome a new staff member on May 1st. Third, I want to say thank you for allowing me to continue as your pastor.

Our Mission Committee has found an opportunity to assist in the cleanup efforts in the Gulf region following the harsh weather there last fall. This is a Mission trip within the United States and a chance to share God's love and grace with folks still trying to get back on their feet. For all those who would rather do mission work here in the United States, this is a great way to be involved. If you feel that physically this is not something you can do, there are many other ways you can help this mission team as they prepare for this trip. On Wednesday night, June 7th at 8:00 pm we will share a community wide event with a Family Movie Night. The movie that night will be "The Incredibles." This is to compliment our VBS theme based on heroes. The movie will be fun and an opportunity to invite friends, neighbors and family to an event here at JUMC. The hope is that we will also encourage them to join us the next three Sundays for worship where I will attempt to tie Biblical ideals to The Incredibles. We will have a flyer each week in the bulletin that you can use to share with someone you would like to invite. If you want more of these please contact the office and we will print them up for you. I am considering what our July 12th movie will be. I am looking for something not necessarily animated. Both movies will be family friendly and we want to have as many folks as possible here filling our parking lot for this family movie night/summer sermon series.

In December 2016 a recommendation from the Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) was presented to the Church Council to add a new staff position, Director of Congregational Care. This position will assist the pastor in the care of the needs within the church. This will include homebound and hospital visitation as well as building upon our current older adult ministry area. This new job description removes some responsibilities from our Director of Christian Education and our Director of Youth Ministry. This will allow each of them to give more time to the families of our children and our youth. To fill the position we sought help from our District Superintendent, John Pinson. The DS recommended that we consider working with a local Pastor serving a UMC in our area. The church that rose to the top was Hinton UMC and their pastor Rev. Gerry Gleason. Gerry is a candidate for ministry out of JUMC and his family continues to be connected to our church. The SPRC discussed the idea and agreed it was a good place for us to start. I sat down with Gerry and talked it over and after conversation and prayer with his wife, Tiffany, Gerry stated he was interested in the position. Gerry and I had a meeting with the DS to discuss what this relationship would look like and reached the understanding that Gerry would remain appointed to Hinton UMC and work on our staff part time as well. Gerry is not appointed to us, he is a part time employee. The SPRC, the DS and I feel this is a correct step for this congregation as we move forward and I feel Gerry will be a wonderful addition to our staff. Pray for him and his family and send him messages of greeting as we prepare to welcome him and his family to our staff.

On April 2, for the first time in my 28 year ministry, the new appointments were announced in pulpits and placed on the ngumc.org website for all to see. This is something new for our North Georgia Annual Conference and I feel a good thing. Since nothing was said from our pulpit on April 2nd, that means I will be returning for a third year and I want to thank you for allowing me to be your pastor once again. Our UMC process is very different from other Christian denominations. Both your SPRC and pastor are asked to be part of the system, the SPRC speaking for the church and the pastor speaking for their family. Sometimes the church's and pastor's wishes are set aside for the betterment of the North Georgia Annual Conference and moves take place that are not expected. We have to trust that God is involved in all these moves both the ones asked for and the ones that come as a surprise. At this point there should not be any new surprises. So once again thank you for allowing me to be your pastor for another year and thank you for being the body of Christ and for supporting the ministry with your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service and your witness. We have come a long way in a short time and God has much more for us to do in the future

As always, thank you for being the body of Christ here in Jasper.


