Gleason is also pastor of Hinton UMC and has preaching responsibility there at 11:00am. This was a suggestion to the job description by the Staff Parish Relations Committee to give me a break once or twice a month. Now I am sure there are other rumors that have not made their way to my office and I encourage each person to bring them to me or other leaders within the church so we don't make mountains out of mole hills or issues where none exist. My leadership style is open door and a healthy flow of communication. If you feel that is not going on please come let me know.
