As seen from the Meadows...

March 2019 is here and yet it feels as though it should be later in the year. Maybe it has just been a heavy beginning to 2019. This month I want to begin by inviting you to our Ash Wednesday service, followed by an invitation to an informational meeting concerning the 2019 called General Conference. I will then close with some thoughts concerning needs we have here at JUMC as we strive to move forward in ministry here in Pickens County.

Ash Wednesday service will be Wednesday, March 6 at 7:00pm. It is the beginning of the season of Lent and is meant to bring us to our knees. This service calls us to realize and grapple with the depravity of humanity and our tremendous need for God. Ash Wednesday is meant to break us down to our very core and then encourage us to fill that core with God's love and grace as we pray, fast and study during the 40 days of Lent. It is one of the hardest services of the year, but living a life formed to the image of Christ is not always easy. Come join us as we share this time contemplating

our mortality and realizing we are dust, and to dust we shall return.

If you are not aware, our United Methodist denomination completed a called General Conference on Tuesday, February 26. This called General Conference was to consider possible changes to our statements in the Discipline concerning the homosexuality and the LGBTQ community. I do not have enough room or words to explain fully what I understand concerning the results of this meeting. What I can say is some are happy with the results, some are sad, and some are struggling within the body of the worldwide United Methodist Church. There are many articles and personal thoughts out there and I would encourage you to read many remarks from both sides of the matter and not just the one with which you agree. To get a better understanding I want to invite you to join me on Sunday, March 17 at the Kennesaw UMC, 4:00pm-6:00pm. As we gather with our brothers and sisters from the Rome/Carrollton, Atlanta/ Marietta and our own Northwest District, we will receive information from leaders within the North Georgia Annual Conference. This will not be a time of debate but a time to receive information and to learn about the process within the Denomination. Between now and then my door is open and I am willing to have conversations with open minds and open hearts concerning our thoughts on this subject. I will close with one final thought concerning the 2019 called General Conference: remember there are mixed emotions on this issue and we have folks happy and some sad. So pray before we speak and seek God's grace with our words.

Now on to needs here at JUMC. These are needs as we continue to offer ministry that makes disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. The first need that comes to mind, is one that has been talked about for a number of years and has a committee in place working on its completion: a new organ. Plans are underway, and money donated but more is needed to see this completed. If you are interested in this area, please let me know. Another item being discussed, that has received a donation is a new electronic sign. This of course would allow us to share information in a new and updated format with our community. The trustees have discussed that we need some updates within our worship space. Things such as new chairs, paint in entrance and other areas, and continued upgrades needed concerning our sound system. By the way, there is a little money remaining from our donations for audio/visual improvements a few years ago. A continuing need is our parking. This is by far the largest and most costly improvement needed and in my opinion the most important, because all the others will not matter if we do not have a place for folks to park. If we are going to make the best use of the facility we have we must make strides in our limited and difficult parking. I bring all of this to your attention because we need to have prayer and conversations about all of these items. I will be talking with our leaders and seeking the best way to move us forward to see all of these needs fulfilled. Committees and good leaders are in place to lead us and share with the body so you can prepare yourself to respond as priorities are set and possible solutions are determined. Keep praying and seeking God's blessings.

To close this month I want to thank everyone for your prayers, concern and understanding with my injury to my right ankle. I see the doctor again on March 11, and I hope to have a different apparatus that will allow me to drive once again and move around easier so I can be a little more normal. Your prayers are appreciated and needed, for my family and me, as they drive me around. Also, thank you for allowing me to be your lead pastor here at JUMC. I strive never to take

for granted the honor and privilege that is mine to be a pastor in the United Methodist Church.
