As seen from the Meadows. . .

When I was 10 years old I could not even fathom 2020 and now here I am in March 2020. I am going to share with you today some thoughts concerning the season of Lent, give you some updates on parking lot plans and to offer you a place to go to gain information concerning the United Methodist Church 2020 General Conference and the Protocol legislation that has received so much press the last few months.

Lent is the 40 days beginning with Ash Wednesday and ending on Holy Saturday not counting Sundays as the 6 Sundays of Lent are considered little Easters and do not count in 40 days of Lent. These 40 days are meant to be a time of reflection and contemplation to review our relationship with God in and through Jesus. Has our relationship increased or decreased over the last year, have we experienced new understandings of the world in and through the eyes of Jesus? The 40 days of Lent can change our relationship with God and with humanity. Whether you take on something new to stretch your understanding or you give up something to connect with the concept of sacrifice: either one can enable us to experience God's presence and blessings. Try and take advantage of the gift of 40 days of spiritual reflection, it just may change your life.

In March 2019 I reminded us of a few projects ongoing and not yet off the ground for improving our now 22- year - old campus. One of those items was the parking lot between the main building and the church office building. The Long Range Planning Committee asked for and received permission to hire a surveying company to present a plan to change our current parking area. Those plans have been received and affirmed by the Long Range Planning Committee and will be presented to the Trustees this month for their vote. If the Trustees agree, the plans will then be presented to the Church Council for their vote and if the Church Council approves the plans, the Long Range Planning Committee will begin putting the job out for bids on actually doing the work. Once the bids are in and approved by the same three committees the Finance Committee will then begin the conversation of how we will seek the funds to see the work completed. All of us need to be in prayer for this work and for the funds that will be needed to see it take place.

I have had some questions concerning the state of the United Methodist Church and what the future holds for us, the Jasper UMC. I feel that our North Georgia UMC Conference website has a very good posting from the Rev. Tom Berlin. Rev. Berlin is a United Methodist pastor in the Virginia Annual Conference and has been very involved in the process for many years. I recommend you consider taking the few minutes to listen to Rev. Tom Berlin at https://revtomberlin.com/talking-about-the-protocol/. I feel this is a good way to gain a better understanding of what has happened and what is happening now. If you have questions please let me know, as my door is always open.

To close this month I want to remind everyone of the Marriage Enrichment Group that meets Saturday, March 14 at 6:00pm here at the church. Dinner and childcare provided. 


