This month I want to update you all on our Director of Christian Education/Children's Ministry, remind you of our worship schedule change on August 15 and encourage you to join me in the study The Disciple's Path.

I am excited to share with you we have hired Kelly Wisniewski as our new Director of Christian Education/Children's Ministry. In the September newsletter, we will share Kelly's bio to allow you to know a little more about her. On Sunday, August 22, the United Methodist Men are sharing a welcome back to worship luncheon and we will be sharing a blessing for the Sanders family. We want to wish them God's blessings in their new journey. So join us Sunday, August 22 to celebrate all Teal has done and look for the September newsletter to officially welcome Kelly to our JUMC Staff!

Back in May, I shared the plans for worship moving forward and since that morning, I have had a few conversations so I want to try to restate and clarify those plans. After school resumes in the fall, Sunday, August 15 our time frame will be 9:00am worship, 9:45am Sunday school and 11:00am worship. Each week we will have both a Traditional and a Contemporary service of worship. Week one, August 15, the Acoustic Awakening Contemporary will be at 9:00am and the Full Traditional at 11:00am: week two, August 22, it will swap Limited Traditional at 9:00am and Full Awakening Contemporary at 11:00am. We will continue that pattern each week. This is due to the fact both styles of worship have become important in the ministry here at JUMC. The question was asked, "Why don't we go back to what we were doing before?" Things have changed and our worship attendance does not warrant three worship services. We have a number of people who continue to view our service online. The other thought was to not have a worship service taking place during Sunday school. This has been one of the main concerns and complaints. This decision was made with conversation and prayer, lots of prayer. If you have questions or just want to share your thoughts, please let me know.

I would like to invite everyone to join me for a small group study beginning Sunday, September 12 at 5:00pm. It will be A Disciple's Path: Deepening your relationship with Christ and the church. The study cost will be \$20 for the books. It will be a seven-week study with an introduction on September 12 and the last session on Sunday, October 24. The study will be 5:00pm -7:30pm. It is a wonderful study to understand better what it means to be a Disciple of Jesus from a United Methodist point of view. If you have questions please reach out and let me know. Looking forward to spending this time with you.

One last thought as I close this month. August 5 I am blessed to have spent 32 years so far with the love of my life. Lydia is by far my greatest earthly blessing. She is my most cherished relationship and my life has been better with her by my side. We will be celebrating on the beach once again this year and I am thankful to have this time with her. I pray you are as blessed as I have been and am!!




