Prior to these opportunities, I had the chance to minister to children through working with organizations like FCA and Winshape.

I foresee a large part of my ministry here taking place at Red Bean Harvest, and let's just say, I'm working my way into being a regular there.

This fall I want to share with you <u>Questions Jesus</u> <u>Asked (a six-week study in the Gospels)</u>, by Rev. Magrey deVega.

Here is the glimpse into the study:

We all have questions for God, but growth happens when we turn things around and ask what Jesus wants to know about us. Why are you terrified? What do you live for? Who do you say that I am? In Questions Jesus Asked, author Magrey deVega explores six of the most provocative questions Jesus posed to others. When we dare to raise them, these questions bring us a fuller appreciation for the wisdom, power and presence of God in our lives.

This study will be Sundays, September 10-October 22, 4:00pm-5:30pm and Wednesdays, September 13-October 25, 6:30pm-8:00pm both nights will be in room 106. The times could change but the dates will not. The cost for the book is \$20.00. I have had the pleasure of participating in a class led by Magrey and hearing him preach, and I am sure this will be a great study and a chance to grow in our relationship with Jesus.
