Welcome to February 2024! I have a few things to share with you this month, some changes in staffing and celebrating a staff member. I also want to invite you to join me in a 7 week small group during the season of Lent. Make sure you check out all the other things going on here at JUMC!

I want to begin by saying thank you to Kelly Wisniewski for her work with us as the Director of Children and Preschool Ministry. Kelly has done a great job and will be missed. Kelly has taken a full time position with the Pickens County School System and has been working for JUMC part time this year since August 2023. After many conversations, she has decided to resign. The Staff Parish Relations Committee and I have discussed the situation and the following plans are in place. Anna Faith Adair will now cover three areas of ministry. She will be the Director of Children, Youth and Marketing Ministry effective February 15, 2024. A new Director of the JUMC Preschool has been recommended by SPR and will be reviewed by the JUMC Preschool Board on February 5, 2024. Once this is complete, the new Director will be officially named on February 15, 2024 as well. These are decisions that were not taken lightly and the SPR and I along with Kelly have been in conversation since December 2023. Please be in prayer for all of these changes and support Anna Faith and the new Director of Preschool, as you are able.

I love living life alongside you all and I can't wait to create more memories with you this semester!



If you would like to read along with the lectionary, the following are the February scriptures from the United Methodist Church Program Calendar:




