So here we are, we have concluded the first quarter of 2024. April is the month when spring begins to come alive. This month I want to share with you concerning Safe Sanctuary training, UMC 2024 General Conference and a question for the 11:00am worship attenders.

The General Conference mandate of 1996 requires all United Methodist congregations regardless of size to implement policies and procedures to make sure no harm comes to those under the age of 18 or vulnerable adults while they are in our care and ministry. Even though we here at JUMC have a Safe Sanctuary policy in place, we have not provided training or even spoken of this policy in years. Thankfully, we have not had one issue, but we should not continue to ignore the possibility of an issue. Since children and youth ministry fall under Anna Faith's areas, I have asked her to work on planning a Safe Sanctuary event and we are hoping to have it take place before VBS in June. This has been an ongoing concern for me and it has been discussed with each director of children and youth. It was discussed a month or so ago during a staff meeting and we are all working to make this happen. Once the date is on the church calendar, please consider joining us for this training.

Well, the time is upon us for the 2020 United Methodist Church General Conference being held in 2024, due to covid-19. General Conference will be April 23-May 3, 2024 in Charlotte, NC. General Conference brings UMC folks from all around the world together to discuss our Book of Discipline, which contain our polity; this is to say our book that states how we operate based on what we hold as our main doctrine. I am going to share an online link where you can read about our General Conference. I encourage everyone to look to our North Georgia Conference website for the best overview concerning day-to-day coverage of General Conference. That website is ngumc.org. RESOURCE UMC is a denominational online site that has information concerning General Conference as well. Please be careful listening to or reading news concerning UMC General Conference from news outlets that do not know how we the UMC do things. We are different in many ways from other Christian denominations concerning our polity, the way we run our business within our denomination. We are a worldwide church so things are done with that knowledge and everyone has a seat at the table.

It has been suggested a number of times that we should go back to passing the offering plates during our 11:00am worship service. Folks feel that would improve our donations each week. I have been told that enough times now that I feel it is time to work that back into our order of worship. To make this happen we need you! Would you be willing to serve on a 4-person usher team? We will offer training Sunday, April 28, after the 11:00am worship service. Please contact the office and let us know you are willing to serve.

As I close out my thoughts for this month, I want to celebrate one of my blessings. In April 1997, Lydia and my lives were blessed with the birth of Gregory, 4/2 and Wesley, 4/3. These two changed our life in so many ways and they have been a blessing for sure. As adult young men, they continue to be not just for us, but are used by God to be a blessing to many as they serve as a Director of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, Gregory, and as a High School Physics Teacher, Wesley. Children's Ministry


