How can I say THANK YOU for 25 years of serving together here at JUMC? We (the Golden 5) arrived in April of 1999 with a 2 ¹/₂ year old son talking around a pacifier, a 9 1/2 year old son with a ton of energy and a 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ year old son who just wanted to play ball with any and everyone in the parking lot and managed to spill about 120 gallons of red Koolaid all over the kitchen floor the first summer of Children's Music Camp! And you kept us anyways!! Thank you for not only loving and supporting me, but my husband who has written countless dramas, taught SS, rewritten the spoken parts for children and youth musicals, written and led many devotional books and sessions at Lake Junaluska for our Chancel Choir Retreats and carried many bell cases and tables over the years. God has richly blessed our family and we have grown from 5 to 14 by adding 3 daughters-in-law, a heavenly little angel and 5 living granddaughters. My ministry started at a very early age when it dawned on me that I should not have survived Childhood Cancer in the mid 60's. So I gave my life to be in service in the sacred world instead of using my musical education in a school setting. My calling was loud and clear so I began leaving SS to practice the hymns on a small 2 manual Organ in my home church. At the age of 14, I was hired to be the Organist/Pianist for Pilgrimage Presbyterian Church and later added the Children and Youth Choirs as well as playing the piano for the youth choir at Norcross 1st UMC. After Andy was born, Norcross hired me to begin their bell ministry and lead the childrens choirs which grew over the next 10 years into Organist/ Associate Director of Music and basically led every age level except the Chancel Choir. As Andy and Christopher got very busy into sports, I began to miss too many of their games and took a smaller job at Harmony UMC for a few years working with the children and youth choirs; and then we moved to the North GA mountains and the commute was just too much. I then began just playing the Organ at Cool Springs Baptist Church when Josh was a baby until a few members of Jasper UMC begged me to send in my resume here for the position of Music/Worship Leader. SO, from the spring of '99 until now, you and I have served together to be His hands, feet and voice inside these walls and all along the East Coast, up to Washington, DC, New York City, over to St. Louis down to West Palm Beach across to New Orleans and everywhere in between.

Jasper United Methodist Church invites you to join us on March 3rd at 11:00 for a music filled service honoring Roxanne's 25 years of dedication to JUMC. To celebrate her retirement and service, a reception will immediately follow.

We have scraped houses, sanded boards, painted about everything, ripped carpets, worked in yards and lots of other mission projects while singing of His love and grace. Thank you for sharing your children, youth and giving so freely of your time and talents to our Music/Worship Arts. Together we have grown spiritually, made some life-long friendships and hopefully learned a few things about singing and ringing. God has been faithful from one generation to another and His mercies are new every morning. "Blessings all mine with ten thousand beside." May God continue to lead and guide us all in this next chapter of our lives. Please remember how much you are loved and always remember to find me around J town and give me a hug or invite me over for a tea party. Lots of love.
