
lives. We will be incorporating a mission along with congregation participation during the play: filling flood buckets for UMCOR. Below is a list of items needed to fill the buckets. Bring the items to the service on Mother's Day. For information call Cathy in the church office.

Flood Bucket Supply List

A flood bucket is a bucket filled with all kinds of cleaning supplies, plus goods like gloves, bug spray and trash bags. These buckets will be taken to UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief) who will take them to areas affected by natural disaster such as hurricanes, flooding, and tornadoes.

Please bring one or more of these items to the 11:00 worship service on Sunday, May 12 for the children to collect during the musical.

- 32-64 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent
- 16-40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate household cleaner. No spray cleaners
- 4-8 oz. pump spray air freshener
- 16-34 oz. bottle liquid dish soap
- 6-14 oz. pump spray insect repellant with protective cover
- Scrub brush (with or without handle)
- Scouring pads (remove from packaging)
 NO stainless steel or pads with soap in them
- 36-50 clothespins
- 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic line)
- 24 ct roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon sizes)
- Pairs of kitchen gloves (durable for multiple uses)
- Work gloves (cotton with leather palm or all leather)
