As seen from the Meadows...

Lydia and I are so blessed to begin our tenth year of ministry here at JUMC! Our first Sunday with you all was July 5, 2015. Man, what a ride so far! As we seek God's grace and love, there are a few items I want to share with you this month: our next Church Council meeting is set, I am sharing a new sermon series this summer, and I want to make everyone aware of a physical need for our church.

In June's newsletter, I shared about our May Church Council meeting and stated I would inform when the next meeting was set. After conferring with our Executive Committee made up of the Church Council Chair, Church Council Secretary, Lay Leader, Lay Member to Annual Conference, Staff Parish Relations Chair, Trustee Chair and Finance Chair, the meeting is set for Tuesday, August 13, 2024, 6:00pm in room 106. The May meeting was an open meeting and we had visitors attend and share their feelings. A decision has been made that the August meeting will be a closed meeting so that the Church Council can focus and work out where and how JUMC is being led. The meeting will once again concern setting a wedding policy and to discuss whether paragraph 2549 is worth the risk to pursue as a way to leave the United Methodist Denomination. Paragraph 2549 calls for a vote at a Church Conference to close the church. If the vote to close the church passes, as the Discipline reads, basically, the property and its future would be in the hands of the North Georgia Conference UMC Trustees. They could place a for sale sign on the property and sell it for the full value to whomever can make the purchase. There was nothing at our Annual Conference to lead us to believe that the North Georgia Conference UMC Trustees are considering any deals at this time. Be in prayer for your Church Council. If you do not know who these persons are, reach out to the church office. We have put together a list for your prayers.

In the spring of 2024. Hed a book study entitled Being United Methodist Christians: Living a life of Grace and Hope. We had over twenty members and visitors participate in that study. Many learned new things and gained a new appreciation for what is means to be a United Methodist Christian. A few members of the class suggested I turn these lessons into sermons so I am trying to do just that. I began on June 23, 2 Timothy 3:16-17, "What is our, UMC, Biblical story?" June 30, will be Hebrews 12:1, "Who are we?" July 14, Luke 15:11-24, "What do United Methodists Believe?" August 4, Ephesians 4:1-6, "How do United Methodists Nurture our Spiritual lives?" August 11, Matthew 25:31-40, "How do United Methodists serve God and our neighbor?" Come join us and reconnect with what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ in and through the United Methodist Church.

In the middle of June 2024 we suffered a big blow. We have had an HVAC unit die. This unit heats and cools the upstairs of the educational wing of the church. We had our HVAC folks come in and check it out and it required a complete replacement and a price tag of over \$24,000. This is an unexpected event that we all have from time to time with our own homes. When unexpected things happen within our households, we might dive into our emergency fund. Well, due to the last few years there is no money in that emergency fund of JUMC. So if you were looking for a place to give some second mile gift, please consider the HVAC 2024 fund. Second mile giving is the money we share after we have given our first fruits to the church for making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. So if you are able, please consider donating to the HVAC 2024 fund.

July 5, 2015 was almost ten years ago. We have been through a lot together and even though 2020 took a bite and church politics have taken a bite, we are still doing ministry, we are still striving to love God and love our neighbor and we will continue to wash feet as we follow the greatest leader the world has ever known, Jesus!
