September 2024, here we come! As we move forward as the Jasper UMC, I have a few items to share with you: A reminder from our Jasper UMC Preschool, a need from our youth group and a thought about how we move forward as a body of Christ.

A number of years ago the Jasper UMC Preschool was started and led by Deborah Goodrum. She was the Director for many years and created a preschool that taught as well as loved and cared for the children of Jasper and Pickens County. Part of that ministry was not turning away a child due to financial issues. Therefore, upon Mrs. Goodrum's retirement we renamed the scholarship fund in her honor. We have children who are using those funds and we will continue to need funds for this ministry. I want to encourage folks to consider making a second mile gift to the Deborah Goodrum Scholarship Fund for the JUMC Preschool. These funds will continue to ensure no child is turned away from our JUMC Preschool. Simply mark you check for the Goodrum Scholarship Fund.

I am sure many of us can remember our teenage years. Mine were blessed with a good United Methodist Youth Fellowship, UMYF. Did you have a youth group that loved and cared for you, that encouraged and inspired you with lessons of Jesus and his love and salvation? Do you remember the names of the adults that made that youth group possible? I do. Those adults played a tremendous role in my life. I bring this up because it is now your turn to help make a youth group possible for teenagers in 2024. Anna Faith needs adults to ensure our youth get to enjoy all the things we enjoyed in our youth groups. Our JUMC Elevate needs a couple of adults to help each week on Sunday evening. We need adults to provide snack supper and just be present with the teenagers. We need adults to help Anna Faith make plans and schedule opportunities for our youth to experience ministry and participate in ministry. Our JUMC youth need those folks who remember how great your youth group was in the day and ensure our youth of today have those same kind of memories. Parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, single and/or married, all are welcomed and needed. I do not think a day goes by without someone reminding me of the number of people we have lost the past few years. I am aware and I grieve the loss as well. I have had a number of people make various suggestions concerning removing some chairs so that it would feel not quite so empty with fewer people on Sunday morning. Believe me I have tried, but we have no place to store the extra chairs. Something we could do to promote a closer-knit body is try to fill the middle section first on Sunday mornings at both the 9:00am and 11:00am services. I know we all have our place we like to sit where we feel comfortable, but why not just try moving to the center two sections? Another thought I have been praying about is to encourage those who have shared with me that you have gotten comfortable worshiping from home to come on back to worship as often as you can. I know there are people who are physically unable to come to worship and virtual worship enables you to be part of your congregation. For those who do not have a physical restriction, your Jasper UMC needs you in person. We need to see one another's faces and know we are here together as the body of Christ in Jasper and Pickens County. If you are one of those who worships weekly with us virtually, please share a hello and interact with one another via the chat on Facebook or YouTube. As JUMC moves forward, please share with me any vision you might have on what we can do to reach out to people in our community.

One last thing as a close, I am looking for a small group study to lead this fall/winter. Keep your eyes open to learn when that will be and what will be our focus. May God's rich beauty fill our lives with grace and love every day.

The ladies of the Dorcas Circle are gearing up for the 43rd Marble Festival Road Race on Saturday, October



It is with a great deal of appreciation and excitement that we bring you this update on our Memorial Scholarship Fund at Jasper UMC. Following the death of our son, Stephen, in 1991, a scholarship fund was established in Stephen's memory. A scholarship (or scholarships) would be given to graduating high school seniors who have been part of Jasper United Methodist Church. We hoped, at that time, that the program could last, at least, until Stephen's younger brother, David, graduated three years later. Thanks to the love you have shown our family and your generosity, there have been 172 scholarships totaling \$110,900 given over the past 31 years! This has been a blessing to so many families.

The other good news is that the scholarship fund now exceeds \$50,000 and is an "Endowed Scholarship" that, along with the interest it will earn, will provide scholarships for our JUMC Seniors for years to come!

Our church family has blessed us in so many ways over these past years and we now invite you to look at other opportunities to share the same kind of love you have shown to us. Perhaps there is another special mission, program, or church budget toward which you would like to direct your love offering. Please spend time in prayer to see what the Lord might be leading you to do at this time.

In closing, thank you again for all the love and consideration you have shown to our family over all these years and may God bless you in some special way as you have blessed us.
