Month number ten of 2024, are we ready? Jasper UMC, we have been through a lot of things these last few years, some good and some not so good. That is the way life is lived. If we really think about it, the good always out numbers the not so good. The problem is the not so good is loud and in your face; it is hard to see past. We have plenty of good things; blessings and possibilities here, so let us look past the loud, not so good and see the blessings of Jesus.

Prayer, we say the word and we know what it means but do we use it, do we do it with hope and promise? Every one of us can pray, young and not so young, mobile and not so mobile, wealthy and not so wealthy. Prayer is a cornerstone of the Christian faith. Everything we do and hope to do needs prayer. I invite you to pray for the body of Christ here at Jasper UMC. We are at the beginning of something new; we are seeking to revive and renew our spirit both individually and as a body of Christ. The Holy Spirit is the only way to describe what I experienced as the Mission Matter team discussed "what we ask our people to pray?" I begin to hear in my heart and mind "renew a right spirit within me". I knew it was scripture, but not sure where it was in the Bible. Therefore, I looked it up and found Psalm 51:10, "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me." I want to suggest praying this Psalm every day, once with "me" and once with "Jasper UMC" in the place of "me". Psalm 51:10 is a psalm of forgiveness, "Create in me a clean heart, O God," and renewal, "and put a new and right spirit within me." This prayer places us in the hand of God so that we can be a vessel of God. Therefore, we can see God's blessings and be God's blessing in the world.

Who are we? Well, we are the Jasper UMC, right? However, what does that mean? Over the last number of years, I have had the honor and privilege to be your Pastor and to be in ministry alongside this body of Christ. We have a mission statement as United Methodists to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. So how do we, JUMC, live out that mission statement? What is the culture of our church? I would like to recommend to us three words to describe the culture of Jasper UMC based on John 13:1-35. This is that wonderful scripture where Jesus washes the disciples' feet, shares Holy Communion and gives them a new command. The first word is Welcoming. Jesus welcomes the disciples with the washing of their feet around the table. I have heard it often JUMC is a welcoming church. There are those who are blessed with the gift of hospitality, which makes us Welcoming. The second word is Growing. The disciples were together to share in the Passover meal. Something they had done all their lives. Jesus used this meal to teach them the importance of servant leadership, about the sacrifice he was to make and the command to love one another. Growing in our faith is the essence of being United Methodist Christians. Jasper UMC has Growing in faith as part of our culture with Sunday School, Small Groups and Studies of the Bible and Topics. The final word is Love. Jesus both models and commands the disciples when it comes to love. The washing of their feet even those who were not clean and would deny they ever knew Him. This showed love and his words could not be clearer, this command I give you... to love one another as I have loved you... by this they will know you are my disciple if you love.... Love has to be the core of our culture; it is what drives the other two, Welcoming and Growing. Welcoming, Growing and Loving are who we, Jasper UMC, are! Welcoming to all, Growing in Faith and Loving, as God loves us. Can you see this in your church? Do you feel this in your church? Will you live this in your church? I challenge you to live into this culture here at Jasper UMC.

To close this month's thoughts, I want to restate with what I started this edition of As Seen From the Meadows, We have plenty to good things; blessings and possibilities here so let us look past the loud, the not so good and see the blessings of Jesus.


